To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On November 10, 1977, we received copies of the President's third special message for fiscal year 1978 that was transmitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974.

The special message includes four new deferral proposals totaling \$908.6 million in budget authority affecting the Departments of Defense and Energy, the National Science Foundation, and the Emergency Refugee and Migration Assistance Fund. The message includes revisions to five previously transmitted deferrals.
