
To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On December 4, 1996, the President submitted to the Congress his first special impoundment message for fiscal year 1997. The message reports seven deferrals of budget authority. We have reviewed the deferrals and found them to be in accordance with the Impoundment Control Act, 2 U.S.C. § 681, <u>et seq</u>., as amended.
