#### INTRODUCTION

This listing is intended to serve as a guide to key library resources useful for foreign country research.

The guide presents selected basic reference works in a wide variety of areas--defense, energy, economics, demographics, etc. For important periodicals, see the companion publication, International Affairs: a Listing of Major Journals, compiled and published by Technical Information Sources and Services, available in the Audit Reference Services and Law Libraries. Similarly, the area of international energy statistics has been separately treated in Basic Sources of International Petroleum Statistics, an analytical bibliography produced by the Technical Information Sources and Services Branch in 1980.

In addition to the printed sources listed in this guide, Technical Information Sources and Services has access to a number of on-line data bases in both general and specialized subject areas which would be useful in foreign country research. GAO staff can check with their appropriate Audit Reference Services division specialist for details on requesting a computerized literature search.

The works listed are located in the Audit Reference Services' collection\*unless otherwise indicated.

Data on countries (Parts II and III) provides names of government officials, information on political parties, diplomatic representatives, religious bodies, the press, and names, addresses, and officials of banking, industrial, and transport organizations.

The following regional surveys supplement information in Vol. 2 of the Europa Year Book. Each includes general surveys on the region, regional organizations, individual country surveys, including geographic, economic, and historical information, and a "who's who" of the regions.

Lists by country foundations operating on an international scale. Information provided by each entry includes name and address of foundation, history, activities, financial data (assets, expenditures, etc.), and names of trustees or members of governing board.

Gives concise biographies of prominent world figures in all areas of activity. Published annually.

Provides useful contacts for country research. Lists names and telephone numbers for regional bureau officials within the State Department, country officers, and addresses and telephone numbers of chanceries in this country. Published semiannually.

Lists and describes in detail the world's universities, research institutes, libraries, museums, and learned societies. Arranged alphabetically by country with a section on international organizations in volume 1. Provides addresses, telephone numbers, officials' names, publications, etc.

A 2-year registry of future scientific, technical and medical meetings. Each quarterly update indexes meetings by keyword, location, and sponsor. The main entry section provides basic information on each meeting, including dates, publications, exhibits, and attendance.

The Scholars' Guides to Washington, D.C., prepared by the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars, serve as reference resources to area studies. These listings of resources include collections in libraries, archives and manuscript depositories, museums, galleries, churches, data banks, associations, government agencies, and research centers. Each entry describes the resources available, provides names of contact people, hours open for research, and publications available.

Each handbook covers a different foreign country and describes and analyzes its economic, political and social systems. The books provide geographic and historical information and include maps, photographs, and extensive bibliographies.

International statistical information in quick reference form compiled by the Statistical Office of the United Nations, its specialized agencies, and other international organiations. Country section arranged by regional groups—then by product and functional headings. Company section is alphabetical by name. "Source Materials" (key to publications cited) with complete address, price, etc. in each volume. Published monthly with annual cumulations.

Monthly listing of the Library's newly-acquired items. Materials are primarily concerned with banking and finance, although some general materials are included. Breakdown by continent, then by country.

Semiannual directory of banks, providing addresses, officers' names and financial information. The substantial foreign section, which follows the listing of American banks, is arranged by continent, then by country.

Volume 2 is an alphabetical index to subsidiaries showing parent company.

Companion to Who Owns Whom: Continental Europe providing company ownership information. Special sections include 1) foreign investment in British and Irish companies, and 2) consortia: lists of members for North Sea oil groups, consortium banks, and other types of company associations.

Taken from the data files of the World Bank, this volume presents statistics in three sections: 1) basic economic data for individual countries, 2) comparative economic data, and 3) comparative social indicators for 1960 and 1970. Most recent data covers the year 1975.

Presents major labor statistics for 180 countries. Coverage is usually for the last 10 years, arranged by subject groupings such as wages, population, hours, etc., then by continent and country within each group. Includes reference sources and country index. In English, French, and Spanish.

OECD Bulletins of Foreign Trade series covers the economic situation of the OECD countries individually and collectively. The following bulletins are included in the Audit Reference Services collection:

OECD Economic Surveys, prepared annually, provide detailed information on the economic development and forecasts for each OECD country. Each gives current descriptive and statistical information on the country's production, government revenue, and foreign trade.

The Army Library periodically prepares extensive bibliographic surveys of strategic areas of the world based on the Library's collection.
